



Sunshine and Rainbow Home Learning ideas:

Maths

- Use your number track to play some games: hide numbers, find a number, say the number that is one more / one less than a number, count in 2s to 20, chose a number and count on to 20.
- Get some toys, then add some more, how many are there all together? Then try taking some away, how many are there now?
- Go on a shape hunt, look at food packaging, what 3D shapes are they?
- Share some food or toys between family members. Can you make it fair?
- Watch Numberblocks (CBeebies)
- Draw some Numberblocks

Literacy

- Read the school reading books
 - Listen to stories and make up stories
 - Practise reading the red tricky words
 - Try spelling the tricky words (i.e. the, to, I, no, go, into, we, me, he, she, be, said, was)
 - Write some 3 letter words (i.e. rug, pen, dog)
 - Write some simple sentences (i.e. I can..., The dog is big.)
 - Write some silly sentences (i.e. A hen in a hat. A cat in a bag.)
 - Write a diary (all words do not need to be spelt correctly, children can use their Fred Fingers to sound out words)
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- Go on a walk and take photos of signs of spring
 - Go for a muddy puddle walk
 - Find a pond and look for frogspawn
 - Plant some beans and keep a bean diary (photographic/drawn/written)
 - Draw a picture of your favourite toy
 - Make a video of yourself doing something you love
 - Build a model, write a label (i.e. I made a...) and take a photo for Tapestry
 - Junk modelling using recyclable materials
 - Practise and perform a song with actions
 - Explore items that float and sink using a washing up bowl and water
