

### School Uniform

- ★ Black shorts for warmer weather and black jogging bottoms for colder weather
- ★ Red PE T-shirt, with the school logo, or a plain red T-shirt

# Covid Safety Measures Next week and September

We will be continuing with our one way systems for dropping off and collecting children next week and when we return in September. We are also continuing to ask that only one adult comes to school to drop off and collect and that any adult coming onto our site wears a mask, both next week and in September. We hope that we will be able to relax these systems later in September, but at the moment with case numbers rising locally, we feel it is safe to keep them in place.

From September for children in Jasmine, Poppy, Pine and Gorse, the one-way system remains the same as the children are remaining in the same class. For the children moving classes, the details for their new class are as follows:

- ★ Oak and Maple Please use the gate by the side of the school office to enter the school site in the morning, and exit using the double gates onto the car park. In the afternoon, please use the double gates to enter the site and exit using the gate by the school office.
- ★ Holly and Bramble Please use the gate at the top of the main playground, at the end of the footpath that runs alongside the school to enter the site and please exit using the double gates partway down the footpath.
