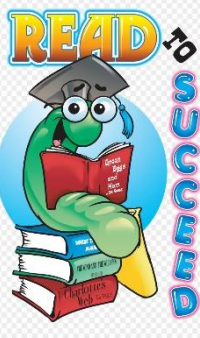

Read to Succeed

It was lovely to present the first reading certificates of the year this morning. We ask that parents listen to their children read on a daily basis and record this in the reading record. We count a read a day and present the children with certificates for every 25 reads so those children who are reading daily should be reaching 25 reads now. Please support your child with their reading as daily reading at home makes such a difference to the progress the children make. For our youngest children, we count stories you read to them while they are not yet ready to read to you because we also value this as a crucial part of learning to read so do please make a note of the stories you share with your child. When a child reaches 200 reads during the school year, we present them with a badge and at the end of the year we have a special celebration of their achievement.

PCR Testing

It is important to make sure you get your child PCR tested should they show ANY Covid symptoms. This will help us to reduce the spread in school for both pupils and staff. We know it can be a nuisance and that children get coughs and temperatures for all sorts of reasons but there are a high number of cases in Frome at the moment so we would appreciate parents being extra careful.
