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COVID Update


Unfortunately, we do have a number of positive and suspected COVID cases at school at the moment. Please continue to be extra vigilant for any sign of COVID and make sure you book a PCR test for your child if they are unwell or display any of the known symptoms. Track and Trace should work with parents if a child tests positive to identify and inform close contacts, but we know that there is very little Track and Trace involvement where children are concerned. As a school, we are not able to identify individual children, quite rightly, but we will let classes and year groups know when we have a cluster of cases. We currently have more than one case confirmed in Year 4 and Year 2.
