## Ukraine



In light of the terrible events currently happening in Ukraine, we have some resources to share with those parents who may wish to discuss the issue with their children but feel unsure exactly how to. We are not suggesting that all parents should do this, but we are aware that some of the older children know something of what is going on and are keen to talk. We also know that it can be hard as parents (and for us as teachers) to know what may be the right thing to say or do and felt the links might be helpful. We are also sending out an edition of First News, which is a newspaper designed for children, and which we have permission to share free of charge in this instance. There are some articles within the edition which parents might find helpful to read as they may guide you in the level and tone of conversation to have with your child. We are not recommending that the children read the articles on their own as we feel this could cause anxiety.

It is not something we are universally addressing in school, especially given how young our children are. However, if the children start to talk about it, we will handle any subsequent discussion sensitively, answering the children's questions as best we can and reassuring them that they remain safe.

## Weekly Art

This week the children have been looking at Andy Warhol's Campbell's soup cans.



### Questions to help support discussion

- Andy Warhol said that ate Campbell's tomato soup every day for 20 years. What would you like to eat every day for 20 years?
- What would you not like to eat for 20 years?
- When an artist repeats a pattern over and over again what effect does it have on the viewer?
- Why do you think Warhol made so many Campbells' soup can paintings?

Here are some lovely photos from activities this week.

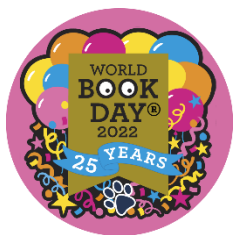
