

Read to Succeed

We love handing out lots of reading certificates in Stars Assemblies as that means you and the children are doing a great job with reading at home. This really helps to support the children as they develop their reading skills, not just


those early skills of recognising words but also their comprehension, fluency and expression - especially if adults also read to the children as well as listening to the children read. We do lots of reading in school, but it is well known that children make even better progress when our work in school is supported by lots of reading at home so we really do appreciate all the help we can get with teaching the children this vital skill.

Children who have read 5 times a week since we returned to school in September (not including the holidays) will have reached 130 reads by now. Those children who have read 7 days a week in term time will have reached 182 reads. So lots of children will nearly have reached 200 reads to become a Golden Reader, which is brilliant. There is still plenty of time for children to catch up!

For those children who have read 7 days a week in the holidays as well will have 210 reads now and are our GOLDEN READERS.
