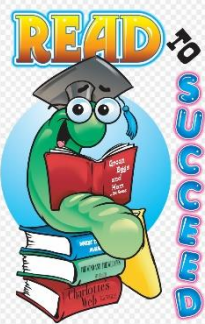
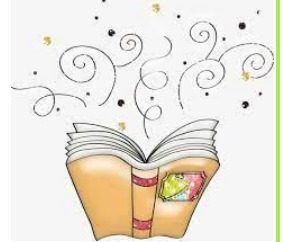

Music Listening

The children have spent their first week back looking at this piece again by Gustav Holst.

[CBC - Ten Pieces - 'Mars' from 'The Planets' by Gustav Holst](#)

Mars from the Planet Suite - by Gustav Holst.

The key feature of this piece is that it is written in 5/4 time which simply means there are 5 notes to each bar. You could 'feel' this with the children by stamping on the strong beat 1 and count the rest of the bar. Stamp, 2, 3, 4, 5 etc.

This time signature helps give the piece its urgency. We, as listeners, are really used to listening to pieces in 4/4 time (count 1 2 3 4, most rock/pop is in this time signature) or 3/4 time (1 2 3 - like a waltz).

5/4 is unusual. Another piece we might know and recognise in 5/4 is Mission Impossible.
