Elvis Presley - Hound Dog (Official Audio)

"Hound Dog" is a <u>twelve-bar blues</u> song written by <u>Jerry Leiber and Mike Stoller</u>. The **12-bar blues** (or **blues changes**) is one of the most prominent <u>chord progressions</u> in <u>popular music</u>. We heard Ma Rainey's 'Runaway Blues' last week.

"Hound Dog" has been recorded more than 250 times. The best-known version is the July 1956 recording by <u>Elvis Presley</u>, which ranked number 19 on <u>Rolling Stone</u>'s list of the <u>500 Greatest</u> <u>Songs of All Time</u>, it is also one of the <u>best-</u> <u>selling singles of all time</u>. Presley's version, which sold about 10 million copies globally, was his bestselling song and "an emblem of the rock 'n' roll revolution".

Elvis Aron Presley was born on January 8, 1935, in Tupelo, Mississippi. and died in 1977. Musician and actor Elvis Presley rose to fame in the mid-1950s—on the radio, TV and the silver screen and is one of the biggest names in rock 'n' roll history.

Elvis Presley came from very humble beginnings and grew up to become one of the biggest names in rock 'n' roll. By the mid-1950s, he appeared on the radio, television and the silver screen. On August 16, 1977, at age 42, he died of heart failure, which was related to his party lifestyle. Since his death, Presley has remained one of the world's most popular music icons.
