PE and Healthy Living Week

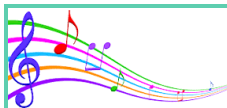

We would also like to thank the [Friends of Trinity First School](#) for supplying the ice-lollies for the children this week.

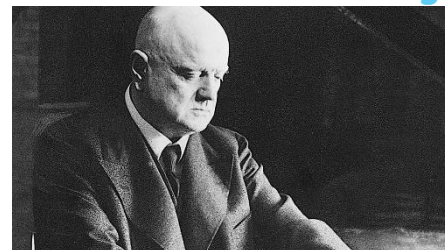


Requests for Term Time Leave

Over the last few weeks we have seen unprecedented requests for term time leave. Please be reminded that parents should only be requesting term time leave in **exceptional** circumstances and when the absence simply cannot be avoided. The expectation is that family holidays, get-togethers, celebrations of special events should happen within the 14 weeks that children are not in school. As a school we cannot authorise any leave unless it meets extremely limited criteria - the wedding of a close family member over which you as parents have no control of the date for instance. Even in that situation we can authorise the day of the wedding and reasonable travel time only; if it forms part of a holiday the remainder of the time taken is unauthorised. From September, any requests for term time leave which are for 5 days or longer will be forwarded to the Local Authority and parents may be fined if the LA decide to take that action.

Jean Sibelius - Finlandia

Sibelius loved Finland. One of his most beloved works is Finlandia, which is about the Finnish people overcoming their enemies. Written in 1899, Finlandia is a tone poem - this means it was composed to portray a particular story. It was written in protest against the increasing censorship by the Russian Empire which was taking place in the late 19th Century.

This is music about national identity. It captures not only the vast, majestic landscape of Finland but also its national pride at a crucial moment in the country's history.

How does music reflect our own national identity? **Listen out for:** The hymn-like theme towards the end of the piece. This was later given words and is one of the most important national songs in Finland, second only to the real national anthem.

The children of Trinity First School would like to invite you to an exciting exhibition of their artwork celebrating the county of Somerset.

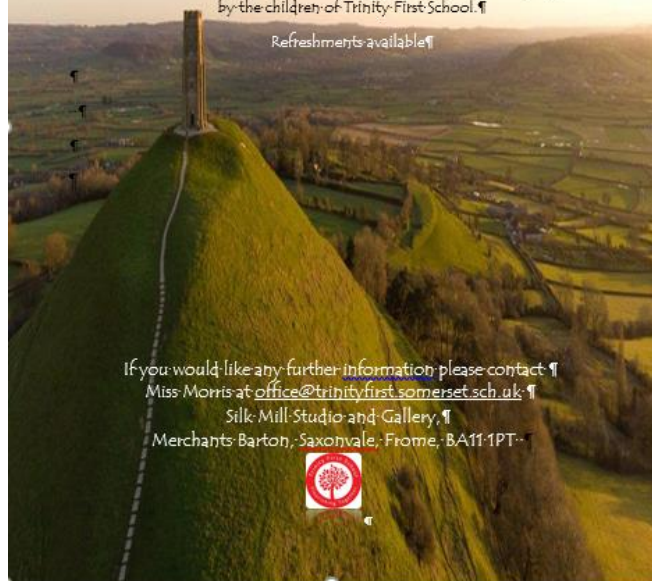
All are welcome to join us from the 11th to the 13th of July at the
