If you have not placed your lunch order for the first week back in September, please remember to bring in a packed lunch as the deadline has now closed.




Wraparound Care September 2022

Message from Chair of Governors

As the school year comes to an end I wanted to take the opportunity to let you know what the governing body has been up to this Summer term and to thank everyone for their hard work.

Governors this term have been in school to do monitoring focusing on the school values (Teamwork, Curiosity, Respect, Resilience and Kindness). We wanted to see how successful the school is in ensuring the children know, understand and demonstrate the values. It was an absolute delight to come into school and see such engaged, hardworking and enthusiastic children. The values are well displayed throughout the school and the children had an understanding of them, and were able to provide examples of them.

Following the Government's White paper, we continue to look into our current status as a Local Authority School and what joining a Trust would look like for Trinity. - Thursday 11th August 9am-1pm

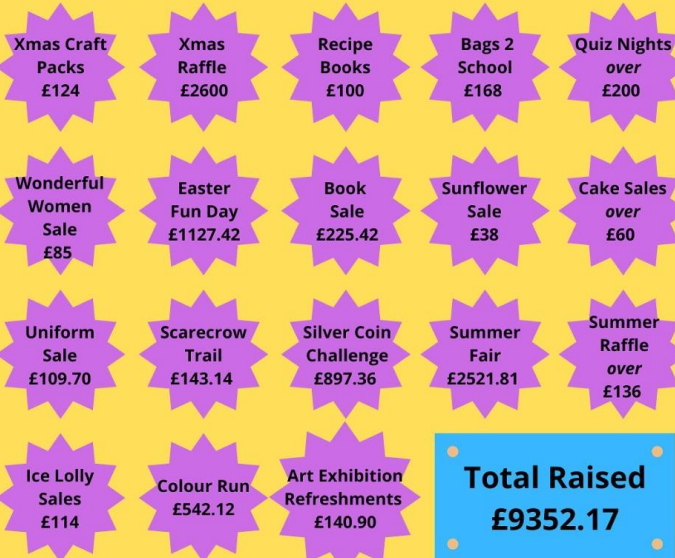
It is FREE to attend and is suitable for age 6 years - 9 years old (Year 2, Year 3 & Year 4).
