- Trainers or daps

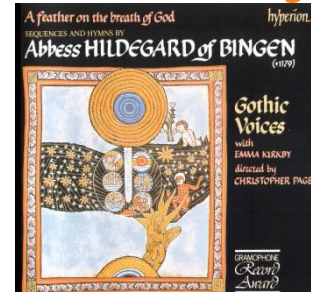

Music Listening

O Euchari - Primarily this piece is one voice which is deeply intense, as a form of personal prayer.

Abbess Hildegard von Bingen (1098-1179) became an unexpected cult figure in the final decades of the 20th century, when her life and work were used as the stimulus for numerous cultural products.

Hildegard was a visionary and a nun whose spirituality had almost magical qualities. Her mysticism, her isolation as a well-documented female composer of the twelfth century, and her melodic style led to Hildegard's association with 'ecstasy' - both in the meanings found to be inherent to her music, and with the interpretation of her works in performance and re-composition.

Possible musical terms: solo (one voice), drone (same note held underneath the melody like a bagpipe), smooth 'legato' singing - no notes are detached. (Fancy term would be 'Melismatic phrasing'), soprano - female singer who sings in the upper, higher note range. Gothic style of music, composed and performed over 900 years ago.
