Message from our Chair of Governors

As this term comes to an end I wanted to take the opportunity to give you an update from the governing body.

We are continuing to look into our current status as a Local Authority School and what the alternative option of becoming an academy and joining a Trust would look like for Trinity. We have met with a number of trusts to find out more about them and what being part of their trust would look like for the school. In the new year we are planning to visit schools to gather further information before inviting the trusts back to present to the board. In the new year, as part of this process, we will be sharing with you information about each of the potential trusts and would welcome any questions you may have, so please look out for this information.

In the new year we will be continuing with our monitoring programme. We will be looking at how successfully the school is meeting its objectives for the year which are around improving the outcomes of children not achieving age-related expectations, enhancing provision for reading beyond Read Write Inc., ensuring the school delivers a rich curriculum and developing leadership roles for pupils and enhancing the pupil voice. We will be visiting the school to meet with teachers and chat to the children.

Thank you to all the staff, children, parents and Friends of Trinity First School for such a fun lead up to Christmas. We have seen nativity performances, carol concerts, festive sing-alongs in residential homes, an amazing musical performance at Wells Cathedral and a brilliant Christmas Fair.
