PE Uniform



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Hygiene Controls

Parents will be well aware that we are experiencing high levels of sickness across the school at the moment. We would like to assure you

that we follow all regulations and guidelines with regard to measures for infection control. We use the most effective cleaning materials possible and ensure that we do not have cross-contamination of cleaning equipment. All toilets, basins, surfaces, touch points and floors are cleaned on a daily basis. Lunch tables are cleaned before and after each use. We also still have regular handwashing throughout the day, and will continue to remind the children of the importance of this. We know that other schools are also experiencing high levels of sickness at this time as well, so while that doesn't make our current situation any easier, it does suggest that the issue is broader than anything happening within our school community.
