Hygiene Controls
Parents will be well aware that before half term we were experiencing high levels of sickness within the school. To ensure we started the term with a completely sanitized school, the whole of Trinity was treated with an Antiviral Fogger Machine during the half term break. This machine is highly effective and kills 99.9% of viruses by distributing tiny droplets of solution onto all surfaces.


