Sustrans Big Walk and Wheel Challenge



Thank you to everyone who supported us in the Big Walk and Wheel Challenge before the Easter break. You did an amazing job, with Trinity coming 120th out of 1,026 schools in our category of large primary schools across the country. **We were the highest-placed school in Somerset, and 4th in the South West.** Over 77% of all journeys to school in those two weeks were made on foot, by bike or on scooters. What a brilliant effort - well done everyone!

UK Emergency Test Alert

As you may be aware, the national UK Emergency Alert test is due to take place at **3pm on Sunday 23rd April 2023**. This is a test of the system which will be deployed in case of future national emergencies. It involves an automatic notification to ALL mobile phones, on ALL 4G and 5G networks, assuming the phone is running iOS 14.5 or later or Android 11 or later. The alert will consist of a message appearing on the screen, together with a loud siren-like alert sound lasting for about 10 seconds. The alert will sound, even if a mobile phone is switched to silent. As parents, you may wish to talk to your children in advance of this to ensure they are not unduly frightened. Some children are very sensitive to noise, and older children who have their own mobile phone may not be aware the alert is happening. 
