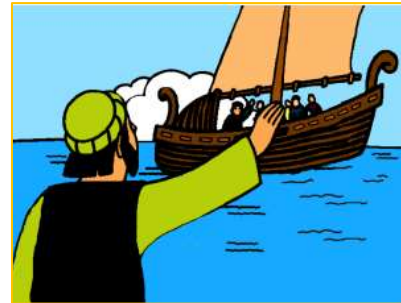

TOMORROW!!

The Colour Run is an untimed obstacle event covering a lap or two of the school field. The run will start with a warm up before runners are doused from head to toe in different coloured powder every few metres. Obstacles are optional and can be avoided if necessary. There are only 2 simple rules:

1. **You MUST wear sunglasses or other eye protection (you will not be permitted to run without)**
2. You finish the race covered in colour!

Tickets can still be purchased

- via PayPal - tsafrome@yahoo.com (using the friends and family option when prompted)

- from one of the FOTFS members in the playground after school TODAY (cash and card accepted)

Tickets are £5 and include a colour run headband and packet of colour powder.

Spectators are free but we request that you make lots of noise to cheer on our runners and, if you have one, bring a water pistol to spray our participants as they race. Everyone is welcome!

FAQ

Is the colour powder safe?

Yes. The powder is non-flammable and non-toxic. It is created in an ISO 9001 certified factory using Corn starch and natural dyes to ensure the safest product possible.

Cont'd...

Does the colour powder stain clothing?

Like any other colour powder yes it can stain clothing so please don't wear your favourite top (unless you mind it becoming colourful)! As with anything dirty, the sooner the gear gets washed, the better. If you would like to preserve the colour in your clothing it is suggested to spray it with vinegar and iron it once you get home.

Does the colour powder stain hair?

The colour powder does wash out of your hair (try rinsing in cold water first), however, we do recommend you take precautions if you are worried. The colour does tend to stick to lighter hair. Using a conditioner/oil before the event can help - apply liberally to your hair and leave in for the event. If you are having trouble washing it out after the event, bi-carbonate of soda and anti-dandruff shampoo can help get the more stubborn colour out.

Alternatively, wear a hat or fun wig!

Is it safe to have cameras/phones with us?

If you want to get shots right in the midst of the colour we recommend covering cameras/phones with cling film or placing in a zip-lock bag.
