Don't forget to order meals for w/c 18th September by midnight on Monday 11th September. If you miss the deadline, you will need to provide a packed lunch for your child.



Many of you will be aware that through the summer term we ran our first parenting course here at Trinity. The course finished and was deemed a great success by

participants and facilitators alike. For all those involved there was an overwhelming feeling that we had learned so much together. Below are some of the reviews from those who attended.

I really enjoyed every session. I learnt some great tips and very interesting views on things I had not thought of. I loved having a safe space to share experiences, concerns and achievements with other parents. I am most grateful for being able to meet other parents, and making new friends.

I really enjoyed taking part in the Parenting Course offered by Mr. Reid. The idea of a parenting course can be daunting, and you might think that you are going to be told how to do things, but the past 10 weeks were all about sharing experiences and learning with each other. More than that, I now feel like, instead of just being "mum at the pickup", I was able to provide the school with a better picture of who we are as a family, and I feel a stronger connection with the school. Parenting can be a hard and lonely job sometimes, but I believe that the connections I made during the course helped me to lighten the load. Thank you!

I did not know what to expect but I have thoroughly enjoyed learning new techniques to approach certain situations you come across as a parent. It was really nice to get to know some other parents and have a support network to talk to. I highly recommend the course and I will be attending future courses they run.

Going forward we hope to run a second course in the autumn term. Timings have yet to be confirmed but please speak to me if you would like to be involved.
