Over the course of this term, the children in Beech and Chestnut classes have been learning about the Titanic. This is always one of the most inspiring topics we learn about at Trinity and this year has been no exception. Today, the children have come into school dressed as if they were going to travel on the ship and they look amazing. They have had such a wonderful day, including a 3rd class passenger meal of bread and water and a 1st class passenger tea of hot chocolate and cup cakes. Having these 'real life' experiences of how it might have felt to go alongside all the facts they have learned is a really important part of their understanding of the subject.

In his PE lessons, Mr Sing has been teaching gymnastics to all year groups. Over the last few weeks the children have been building up their skills and in the lessons this week, Mr Sing has recorded the children displaying what they have learned. There has been lots of teamwork involved, as well as individual skill, and the children have loved having the opportunity to see their efforts on the big screen in the hall.

Finally, this morning we welcomed a visitor from the Frome Kindness Festival to lead our assembly and introduce the main idea for this year's festival. Kindness is one of our Trinity values and I know the children will have fantastic ideas for their poems. Some of the children were so enthusiastic about the project that they have already written poems in their golden time today!
