Across the school we have very much enjoyed the sunshine this week. The children in Sunshine and Rainbow had great fun with the bikes, trikes and scooters on the playground; lots of the classes have been learning how to fence in their PE lessons with Mr Sing and the children in Hazel and Willow had a wonderful trip to Moons Hill quarry linked to their learning on rocks and soils. The staff at the quarry were hugely complimentary about our children, who behaved brilliantly and asked lots of excellent questions to further their learning. The children were described as the best school group to visit the quarry in many months, which is something for the children to be hugely proud of.

We had a wonderful time on Tuesday morning when Olympic medal-winning skeleton athlete Laura Daes visited us. The children all did brilliantly when they took part in the sponsored activities, which were pretty challenging. Some of us adults had a little go and realised we are not quite as fit as we would like to be! The children engaged with the tasks brilliantly and had smiles on their faces throughout. After the activities, Laura spoke to the children about the sport of skeleton, and her career as an athlete. The children had some great questions to ask Laura and many were inspired by her visit. A child in Year 2 told her teacher after the assembly that she wants to be an Olympic swimmer as a result of the things Laura said. Thank you for all of your support for this event. 

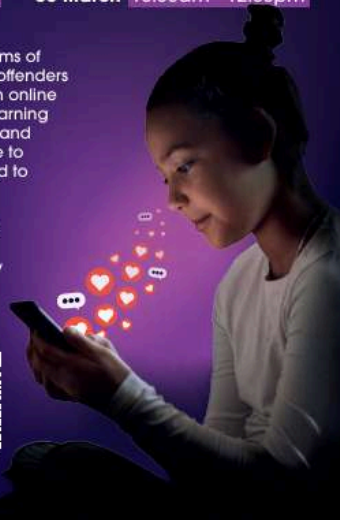
