How lovely to return to school this week in the sunshine! The children have returned with lots of enthusiasm and energy for the term ahead, so thank you for making sure their Easter break has enabled them to recharge their batteries ready for the learning, fun and excitement of the summer term.

I was lucky enough to join the Year 4 children on their trip to the Roman villa at The Newt on Tuesday. This visit links with the learning the children will be doing this term on Roman Britain. The children were guided around the museum and the replica villa by expert staff from The Newt and they really made the most of the opportunity to find out lots of information about that period in our history. One of the things that fascinated the children the most was how archaeologists have studied human skeletons and been able to work out what kind of life the people may have had – whether they were slaves or not, and what kind of work they are likely to have done as a result of the condition of the different bones.

Our three football teams did us proud at the tournament on Wednesday morning, returning with the winner's trophy again, which is very exciting! All of the children played well and represented us brilliantly. Thank you to IG Sports for their organisation, Selwood pupils for their hard work during the tournament and to Mrs Sandquest and Mr Reid for managing our teams on the day.

We have started our Share my Work sessions for this term. If you have already attended your child's, I hope you found it a valuable experience. We have more coming up over the next couple of weeks for the other classes and will be arranging the sessions for the year 3 classes once they have moved into their new classrooms. Swimming - Summer Term Year 2 – Beech and Chestnut



Please note that payment for the Summer Term (Term 5 and Term 6) is now available through Arbor. We have corrected the system and apologise for any confusion regarding the schedule; there will be a total of 9 sessions, with the first session officially beginning on 30th April. However, as the Year 2 pupils will be away on a school trip that day, they will not be attending the session on 30th April.

Consequently, we have reduced the cost of the termly swimming option to £64.35 to cover 9 sessions. While we are unable to amend the specific dates shown on Arbor for those who have already signed up, please be assured there is no swimming on the 30th. If you have already paid the full price for 10 sessions and would like a refund for that missed date, please email the school office.
