HEADS UPDATE

This has been a week of new experiences for lots of our children. The children in Year 2 had their first school swimming lesson yesterday morning, and while there were some nerves, both classes did really well. The children will swim for another 8 weeks this term, and then again in the autumn term when they move into Year 3. Swimming is a very important life skill and so we are very glad to be able to take the children to a pool in Frome to make sure they are all developing their skills – whether that is water confidence, swimming lengths or learning different swimming strokes. This week has also seen our Year 3 children move into their new classes in the Year 5 block at Oakfield. The children were brilliant when they were helping to move some of their books and resources, and have been very excited to be in their new classes. Obviously it is still very early days and there are still some details we need to work out, but the children are busy working hard in their new spaces, and feeling very grown up and responsible. I am really proud of all of the children in both year groups for the positive way they have approached the challenges these changes have presented.

We are also making progress with the plans for our nursery. Before half term, Chestnut class will be moving into the main building to allow the refurbishments works to begin on the building that will become the nursery. All of the staff teams in Year 3 and Chestnut class are working hard to ensure the class moves go as smoothly as possible, and have led the children by example, taking these changes in their stride. Change is never easy (and teachers are notorious hoarders because ‘you never know when this might come in handy!’), but staff and children alike have been brilliantly positive.

Please note that payment for the Summer Term (Term 5 and Term 6) is now available through Arbor. We have corrected the system and apologise for any confusion regarding the schedule; there will be a total of 9 sessions, with the first session officially beginning on 30th April. However, as the Year 2 pupils were on a school trip that day, they did not attend the session on 30th April.

Consequently, we have reduced the cost of the termly swimming option to £64.35 to cover 9 sessions. While we are unable to amend the specific dates shown on Arbor for those who have already signed up, please be assured there is no swimming on the 30th. If you have already paid the full price for 10 sessions and would like a refund for that missed date, please email the school office.
