HEADS UPDATE

This week started with a Read,Write, Inc development day. This involved a RWI specialist visiting school and spending the day with key staff, making sure that we are teaching RWI in the best way possible for all of our children. Across Reception and year 1, we invest a huge amount of time in teaching phonics and early reading using the scheme and so it is important to make sure we are getting it right. Our visitor observed various sessions being taught, including group lessons and individual catch up sessions. She was very positive about everything she saw, and just had one or two pointers to help us to continue to improve.

Our year 2 children thoroughly enjoyed their history of nursing workshops this week, especially when they had the opportunity to bandage each other and their teachers! Across the year children from all year groups have the opportunity to take part in workshops linked to their history topics, enabling them to see and handle artefacts, to dress up in period costumes and to engage in themed activities. The workshops are provided by the Somerset Museum Service and our membership is funded by FOTFS each year. This means we are able to give the children meaningful, practical experiences to enhance their learning without needing to take them out of school, which incurs considerable cost if we need to hire a coach.

Tomorrow FOTFS are holding their annual Colour Run, on the school field. This is always great fun and usually very popular so hopefully we will see lots of you there!

Please note that payment for the Summer Term (Term 5 and Term 6) is now available through Arbor. We have corrected the system and apologise for any confusion regarding the schedule; there will be a total of 9 sessions, with the first session officially beginning on 30th April. However, as the Year 2 pupils were on a school trip that day, they did not attend the session on 30th April.
