## HEADS UPDATE

Although this half term has been short at only 5 weeks, we have packed an awful lot in. Three of our classes have moved, which takes a huge amount of time and effort. It has been brilliant to see the teamwork and resilience from both children and staff, making sure that something that is a major upheaval has been managed so smoothly. Our year 3 children have settled really well into their classes in the year 5 block, and I am sure Chestnut class will also take the move into the main building in their stride when they return after half term.

We have also started the work we need to do to ensure everything is in place for our year 4 children to move successfully to their next schools, sorting out tutor groups, meeting with key staff and collating all the information that we pass on to give their receiving schools a really good understanding of each child. Alongside this, we are busy preparing for our new intake, planning our Stay and Play sessions and classroom visits and arranging meetings and phone calls with nurseries and childminders. It is really important to us that we do the best we can to ensure smooth transitions into and out of Trinity as we know that any period of change can be unsettling if it isn't handled well.

Added to this, of course we are also preparing to add our nursery provision. This is such an exciting development for Trinity, but also a steep learning curve for us. We are planning to start gently and build up to our full capacity over time. We have sent out our first offer letters today, and we are really looking forward to welcoming those new children in September.

It looks like we are going to be blessed with beautiful weather for the half term break. I hope that means you are all able to enjoy a wonderful week with your children.

### Trinity Nursery Opening

September 2026

We are thrilled to be able to start offering nursery provision at Trinity from September 2026. The refurbishment of the building that will be our nursery is due to start at the beginning of June and we are very much looking forward to welcoming our first children in September.

Trinity Nursery will operate in term time only, with opening hours that are in line with our extended school provision – from 8am until 5:30pm Monday to Thursday and from 8am to 5pm on Fridays.

Initially, we will be offering places to children aged from 2 years and 8 months.

### Swimming - Summer Term Year 2 – Beech and Chestnut

Please note that payment for the Summer Term (Term 5 and Term 6) is now available through Arbor. We have corrected the system and apologise for any confusion regarding the schedule; there will be a total of 9 sessions, with the first session officially beginning on 30th April. However, as the Year 2 pupils were on a school trip that day, they did not attend the session on 30th April.

Consequently, we have reduced the cost of the termly swimming option to £64.35 to cover 9 sessions. While we are unable to amend the specific dates shown on Arbor for those who have already signed up, please be assured there is no swimming on the 30th. If you have already paid the full price for 10 sessions and would like a refund for that missed date, please email the school office.
