HEADS UPDATE

This week, our children in Year 1 and Year 4 have completed the statutory assessments required of all children in those year groups.

The children in Year 1 do the phonics screening check, where they are asked to read 40 words that check their knowledge and understanding of the different phonemes used commonly in our language. It is also important that they are able to identify and blend the sounds fluently to make the words to read. The words are a mix of real words that the children may already know or have come across in their reading, and alien words that have been made up.

In Year 4, the children have completed the multiplication tables check. In this, the children are given 25 times tables questions to check their recall of the tables. This check is completed online and the children have to be pretty speedy to be able to perform well, as well as confident at using the iPad to submit their answers.

With both tests, we work hard to make sure the children are really well-prepared for the structure of the test and that they have the knowledge they need to be successful, but at the same time we also want to make sure they do not panic or worry about what they have coming up. We don't have official results yet, but the children approached their tasks brilliantly and have performed to a really good level. We are really proud of all of them.

Trinity Nursery Opening September 2026

We are thrilled to be able to start offering nursery provision at Trinity from September 2026. The refurbishment of the building that will be our nursery is due to start at the beginning of June and we are very much looking forward to welcoming our first children in September.

Trinity Nursery will operate in term time only, with opening hours that are in line with our extended school provision – from 8am until 5:30pm Monday to Thursday and from 8am to 5pm on Fridays.

Initially, we will be offering places to children aged from 2 years and 8 months.
