HEADS UPDATE

As a Church of England school we are subject to an additional inspection – SIAMS (Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools). This is something that should happen every five years, and our next inspection is due next academic year. To help us prepare for this, we welcomed a visitor to Trinity on Monday morning, Paul Marvin, who carried out several of the meetings, conversations and observations that will happen during the inspection. The main focus for all aspects of the inspection is how well we are living out our vision and values across the school, and so this was also the main area of Paul's visit. As part of his evaluation process, Paul spoke to some of the children from Years 1 -4 about our vision and values. They also talked about their learning in RE and the discussions we have when the children talk about our weekly Big Questions on a variety of cultural events and individual feelings and choices. Paul was really impressed with the children, not just the confident way in which they spoke, but also their enthusiasm and their maturity. They really did us proud!

On Wednesday this week we had lots of excitement and a few nerves as the children were able to spend some time in their new classes and schools. For our Year 4 children, that meant spending the day at their middle school. Our Reception children went to their new Year 1 classes, our Year 2 children went to their new Year 3 classes and our new Reception children came to spend some time in their new classes. The day went really smoothly and the children were all very settled when I walked round to see them – there were so many smiley faces! This year in a first, I even saw some of our Year 4 children in their new classes at Oakfield when I popped up to see Hazel and Willow classes! It is a change, and change can be tricky, but change can also be an opportunity and it was lovely to see all of our children using their resilience and curiosity so well on Wednesday.

Trinity Nursery Opening

September 2026

We are thrilled to be able to start offering nursery provision at Trinity from September 2026!

Swimming - Summer Term Year 2 – Beech and Chestnut

Please note that payment for the Summer Term (Term 5 and Term 6) is now available through Arbor. We have corrected the system and apologise for any confusion regarding the schedule; there will be a total of 9 sessions, with the first session officially beginning on 30th April. However, as the Year 2 pupils were on a school trip that day, they did not attend the session on 30th April.

Consequently, we have reduced the cost of the termly swimming option to £64.35 to cover 9 sessions. While we are unable to amend the specific dates shown on Arbor for those who have already signed up, please be assured there is no swimming on the 30th. If you have

already paid the full price for 10 sessions and would like a refund for that missed date, please email the school office.

Additionally, if you are a Trust Fund pupil, you may use your funds to pay for these lessons; simply email the office so we can check your balance and arrange this for you. Thank you.

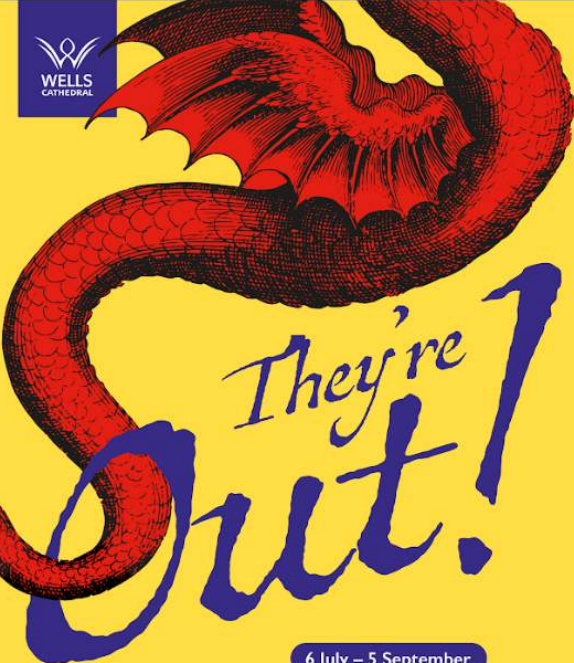
